East & West Nishnabotna River Watershed Planning Services

Fremont and Mills Counties, Iowa are jointly requesting proposals for watershed and flood resilience planning services to assist both the East and West Nishnabotna Watershed Management Coalitions with development of two separate multi-level, FEMA-compliant, comprehensive watershed plans to address flood mitigation and water quality in both the East and West Nishnabotna River Watersheds. The selected contractor will work with both Fremont and Mills Counties, the Nishnabotna Watershed Coalitions, and Iowa Watershed Approach partners.
