FREMONT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PASSES RESOLUTION TO PROSECUTE ACCESS VIOLATIONS IN MANDATORY EVACUATION AREAS.

In a special meeting on March 18, 2019, the Fremont County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution proclaiming a comprehensive schedule of civil penalties for violations of mandatory evacuation and mandatory curfew provisions. Access to areas included in Orders of Mandatory Evacuation is limited to authorized law enforcement, emergency management personnel, and other authorized government officials. Violations may result in a county infraction, punishable by civil penalties in the amount of \$750 for the first offense and \$1000 for a second or subsequent offense.
